1. Milwaukee Art Museum

2. Milwaukee Public Museum

3. Milwaukee Public Market

The Milwaukee Public Market features an array of local vendors from fresh seafood and artisanal cheeses to international cuisine and gourmet chocolatiers.

4. 3rd Street Market Hall

5. Milwaukee RiverWalk

Spanning more than 20 blocks along the Milwaukee River, the RiverWalk winds through the heart of the city, showcasing various bars, restaurants, boat tours, public parks, and residential areas

Drivable Attractions

1. Mitchell Park Domes

Experience a desert oasis, a tropical jungle, and special floral gardens all in one afternoon!

2. Brady Street

On Milwaukee's east side, explore Brady Street's lively neighborhood known for its mix of eateries, boutiques, and vibrant nightlife.

3. Pabst Mansion

The Pabst Mansion boasts stunning interiors, elegant furnishings, exceptional wood craftsmanship, intricate ironwork and a collection of fine arts.

4. Harley Davidson Museum

The best of American design and culture, see more than 450 motorcycles and artifacts dating back to Serial Number One, the oldest known Harley-Davidson motorcycle.

5. Seven Bridges Trail at Grant Park

About 12 minutes south of downtown the Seven Bridges Trial features picturesque wooden bridges and miles of walkable forest, offering scenic views of Lake Michigan.
